



5 Things to Consider When Choosing a Home Care Company:

1. KNOW YOUR NEEDS:

Make sure you have an understanding of what your needs are, because that will help determine what level of care you need. Refer to level of care list attached.

2. BUDGET:

Calculate your budget because this will help in influence how many hours you can afford. Also, ask if they have a minimum per visit.

Private agencies typically work with Long-term Care policies and Veteran's Aid and Attendance Benefits

- -Call your Long term Insurance Provider to see if it will cover Home Care Costs
- -Call your local Veteran's Affairs Office to see if you would qualify for Veteran's Aid and Attendance Benefits (for veterans, spouses and widows of veterans)

3. LICENSED:

Make Sure they are Certified Licensed Provider in your state

4. COVERAGE:

Ask what area does the Agency Cover? And how much of a notice do they need before you want to start care?

5. UNIQUE:

Ask what makes them different? Every agency has things that make them unique to other agencies. Feel them out – do you feel connected with a certain one over the others?
